



5. Crown Flint Color Therapy Sunglasses


15. Pin With Pon

26. Moving Walls






31. Artificial Resurrection

Owning an aquarium can be quite enjoyable, but it comes with plenty of headaches. There's a lot of maintenance that's a part of owning one – maintenance that Aqua Design Innovations aims to get rid of with the introduction of its EcoQube C fish tank.

Basically, all the aquarium owner needs to do is feed the fish. From there, the fish creates waste. The aquarium water – containing that waste – is then pumped up top and filtered through the plant's growing medium and roots to remove nitrates and ammonia, and cycled back into the tank as clean water. The cycle repeats, leaving a fertilized plant and a clean tank.


33. Cat Playhouse

36. Urban Algae



The Urban Algae Folly is the world's first living edible architecture. Inegrating micro-algal cultures and real-time digital cultivation, the system produces 35g of Chlorella every day – or the protein equivalent of 750 grams of meat per day. In just 6 months, the folly can produce the same amount of protein as a small cow, which, according to the designers, is sufficient to feed four people.

Originally presented at the <u>Milan Expo</u> earlier this year, the Urban Algae Folly is a sculptural but functional piece of bio-digital architecture made of micro-algae organisms. Currently on display at the Praça da República, Braga, in Portugal, it is both responsive and adaptive. When the sun shines on the structure, the <u>algae</u> flowing through a series of bags and tubes photosynthesize, constantly changing the appearance in response to the weather conditions of the day.

In 2014, 14 percent of US households had unstable food resources, so it is no wonder that we have seen a number of initiatives that help distribute food among the hungry. In Minneapolis, for example, the police department are distributing healthy food boxes with nutrition advice during their patrol. Now, the Lexington Parking Authority has launched the Food For Fines scheme, during which residents can trade cans of food for a reduction on their unpaid parking ticket fine.

41. Trash To Toys Design



In a remote rural village in Kenya or Malawi, you won't find a toy store, but you'll probably find a shop selling soda. That fact inspired an idea: What if old soda bottles and other packaging could be transformed into toys that children can use for learning?

A new series of designs that turn old packages into simple educational tools could give kids who don't have access to preschool a better chance at learning how to count or read. They were created as a concept for the design firm IDEO.org's <u>Amplify challenges</u>, which asked for ways to help children in low-income areas thrive in the first five years of life.

In one concept, called Bottle Stack, short bottles turn into blocks that can be stacked to learn numbers or spell words. "You can start with your name or simple words, and since you can stack the bottles, you can also make basic sentences," says Bricola.

In another, a bottle becomes a truck that moves with wheels made from bottle caps. "We plan to have a white label on the truck, and invite children to draw their own picture," he says. "It's more about creativity.

It was then that the idea for 'The Shoe That Grows' began to form. "I thought, wouldn't it be nice for them to have shoes that could adjust and expand?" Lee told Christian Today. "That was the spark."

A few years later, in 2006, Lee and a team of friends founded <u>Because International</u>, a non-profit organisation dedicated to "working with and helping those in extreme

poverty". They designed a shoe made of soft leather on top, and durable rubber soles to withstand rough terrain and child's play. They come in two sizes, small and large, which each expand using a system of buckles and snaps to grow five sizes, meaning one pair can last a child several years.


43. Urinal Powered Prototype

44. The Coffee Connecting Machine



Mark Boyle, better known as the "Moneyless man", is bringing his message of unconditional giving to a <u>permaculture</u> project in Ireland called *An Teach Saor*; Gaeilge for "the free house." When it's complete, Boyle's community center will offer workshops and lectures; food from the on-site orchards, gardens, and greenhouses; performances; accommodation; and a pub called The Happy Pig—the majority of which won't cost guests a dime.

Boyle and a team of dedicated volunteers are currently building the property from natural and recycled materials. Anything that isn't free will be <u>crowdfunded</u>. Boyle has already raised the funds to build The Happy Pig pub from an old pig shed, and volunteers have flooded in to learn how to construct inexpensive buildings from materials like <u>straw bales</u> and cob. The structure of the pub cost 11 percent of a conventional build—now the team is raising funds for the interiors, and people who donate could receive gifts ranging from a one-day workshop to a weekend on the property with 10 friends.

47. Doorman Schedule Your Own Deliver Timing




